2023 Highlights



● PATIENT CARE

Throughout 2023, Lake Granbury Medical Center played a vital role in helping people get well and live healthier at more than 298,000 patient encounters across its hospital and growing network of Lakeside Physicians clinics and other outpatient care sites.

● UNCOMPENSATED CARE

We provided over \$69 million in charity and uncompensated care for the community's most vulnerable, and have resources to help them secure medications and medical support devices.

● ADDRESSING SOCIAL DETERMINANTS OF HEALTH

Through financial donations and acts of service, we support the work of local charitable organizations, including United Way and Ruth's Place, and our second Jars of Love Peanut Butter Drive will support Hope Now in Stephenville, Papa's Pantry in Glen Rose and Mission Granbury in Granbury.

● CARDIOLOGY

New technology updates in our cardiac catheterization lab provide image-guided procedures, 3D visualization and lower X-ray dose for the diagnosis and treatment of heart and blood vessel (cardiovascular) diseases.

● EXPANDING EMERGENCY CARE

Our new \$15 million freestanding emergency department at Fall Creek is projected to open in summer 2024.

● INCREASING ACCESS TO CARE

A new primary care clinic and express care center is now open in Stephenville.

Our recruitment of urologist, Bruce Harrell, M.D., and gastroenterologist, Tariq Khan, M.D., means patients are able to locally access critical care, including kidney stone treatment and prostate and bladder cancer care, as well as expanded care for colon cancer, digestive disorders and GERD.

● SURGICAL SERVICES

Two surgical robots allow surgeons to perform minimally invasive procedures that help benefit patients with less blood loss, reduced post-surgery pain, smaller scars and generally, a faster recovery,

Under the leadership of surgeon Todd Belott, M.D., our Bariatric Surgery Center has earned The Joint Commission's Gold Seal of Approval for Bariatric Care.

Our Advanced Knee and Hip Replacement Orthopedic Department, certified by the Joint Commission, provides care for those needing pain relief and improved function for the hands, hips, knees and shoulders.

● WOMEN'S SERVICES & MATERNITY CARE

Our maternity center renovations give us new, patient-accommodating designs and furniture for moms, babies and their families. Our center is recognized for its many innovations, and has received accolades such as being Perinatal Certified and a Texas Ten Step Designated facility. More than 550 babies are born at our center annually.
