## 2024 Highlights

#### • PATIENT CARE

Over the course of 2024, AllianceHealth Durant played a vital role helping people get well and live healthier at more than 100,000 patient encounters across its hospital and other sites of care.

#### UNCOMPENSATED CARE

We provided more than \$75 million in charity and uncompensated care for the community's most vulnerable and have resources to help them secure medications and medical support devices.

#### QUALITY EMERGENCY CARE

Our emergency department delivered medically necessary, life-saving care at more than 27,000 visits in 2024, regardless of the individual's ability to pay.

#### ADDRESSING SOCIAL DETERMINANTS OF HEALTH

Through financial donations and acts of service, we support local charitable and community organizations, including United Way Be a Hero 5K, Colton's Run and the Red River Food Drive, and our second annual Jars of Love drive collected more than 500 jars of peanut and other nut butters for Hands of Hope.

#### GROWING FUTURE PROVIDERS

AllianceHealth Durant continues to work with local colleges, universities and career tech schools to increase the number of clinicians in our community, including nursing students (RN/LPN), EMTs, paramedics, scrub techs, radiology, laboratory, respiratory, medical students and physician residents. The AllianceHealth Durant Family Medicine Residency Program is the oldest Family Medicine program in the state of Oklahoma, graduating more than 90 residents since beginning in 1997.

#### CAPITAL INVESTMENTS

Last year, our capital investments focused on improvements to patient comfort and quality of care, from new mattresses and bedside tables for patient rooms to equipment and technology to support our caregivers in delivering treatment. Our implementation of a new electronic medical record system has improved communication between departments and reduced charting times for staff.

#### • WOMEN'S HEALTH

AllianceHealth Durant's Women's Center is dedicated to providing a supportive and comforting environment for all of the stages in a woman's life, from the delivery of more than 800 babies in 2024 to surgical services, such as hysterectomy. The addition of a wireless fetal monitoring system allows laboring moms to move freely, while still monitoring the fetal heartbeat. We also welcomed OB/GYN Autumn Hensley, M.D., and nurse practitioner Jessica Williams to our Women's Health Clinic.
