# 2024 Highlights

## ● PATIENT CARE

Over the course of 2024, AllianceHealth Madill played a vital role helping people get well and live healthier at more than 74,000 patient encounters across its hospital and other sites of care.

## ● UNCOMPENSATED CARE

We provided more than \$5.8 million in charity and uncompensated care for the community's most vulnerable and have resources to help them secure medications and medical support devices.

## ● QUALITY EMERGENCY CARE

Our emergency department delivered medically necessary, life-saving care at more than 7,800 visits in 2024, regardless of the individual's ability to pay.

## ● ADDRESSING SOCIAL DETERMINANTS OF HEALTH

Through financial donations and acts of service, we support local charitable and community organizations, and our second annual Jars of Love drive collected more than 450 jars of peanut and other nut butters for Bread of Life Ministries. With the support of local organizations, we were able to triple the collection from 2023. The Senior Care Services department hosted the second annual Suicide Prevention Walk, which included a relay race and tug-a-war between Madill Police and Fire Departments, as well as Marshall County EMS.

## ● INPATIENT SKILLED NURSING

Through our inpatient skilled nursing care, 165 patients received short-term assistance in order to return home. Patients receive 24-hour nursing care, as well as physical, speech and occupational therapies during their stay.

## ● OUTPATIENT REHABILITATION SERVICES

We were excited to expand the care offered by our outpatient physical therapy department to include outpatient occupational therapy. Our commitment is to help people regain independence in their daily lives. One of our occupational therapy assistants, Sabrina King, was named Certified Occupational Therapy Assistant of the Year by the Oklahoma Occupational Therapy Association.

## ● SURGICAL SERVICES

Surgical services, such as general surgery, orthopedics and podiatry are now offered at AllianceHealth Madill by AllianceHealth Medical Group providers, Dr. Jay Jacinto, Dr. Chris Leslie and Dr. Svend Bjorn. In addition, clinic appointments are available with Dr. Jacinto and Dr. Leslie at the AllianceHealth Kingston Clinic, supporting access to specialty care in Marshall County.
