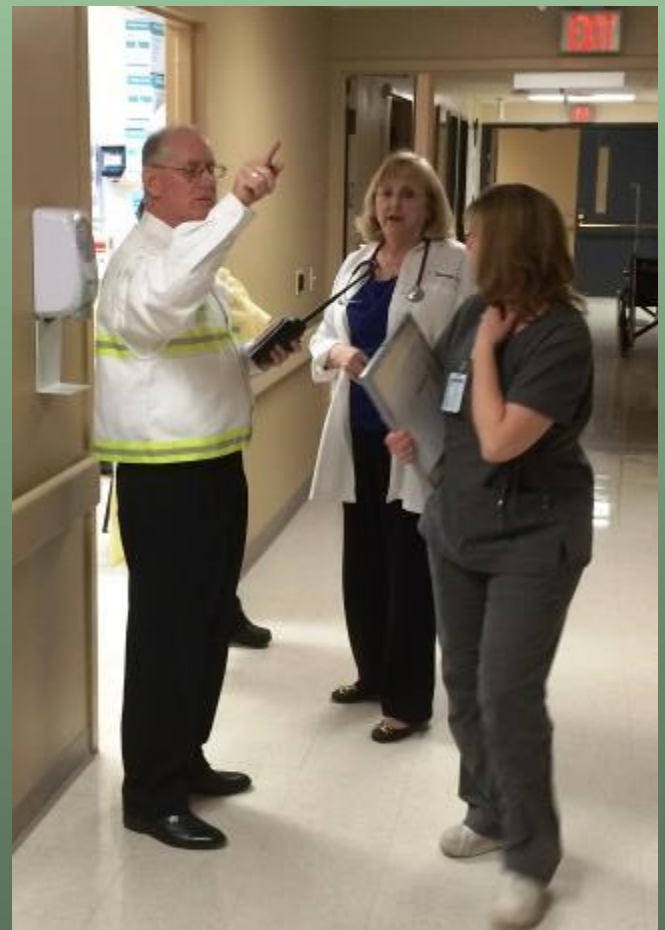

On March 26, the ER Department called a code orange, activating all departments to come help. There was an auto accident along with other ER patients, for an influx of 12 total patients in a two-hour period.

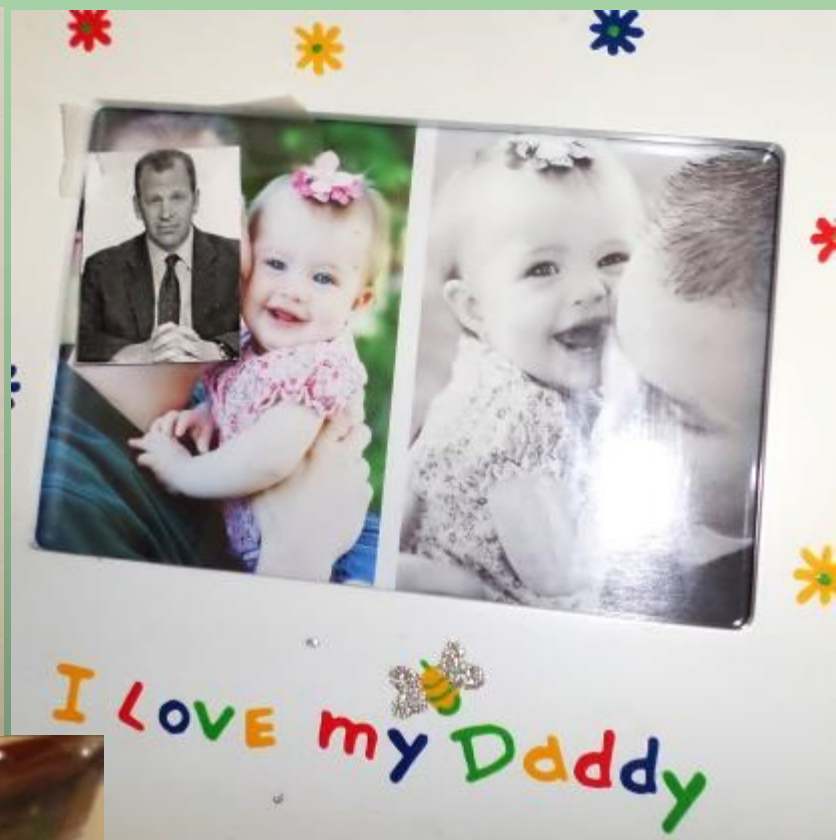

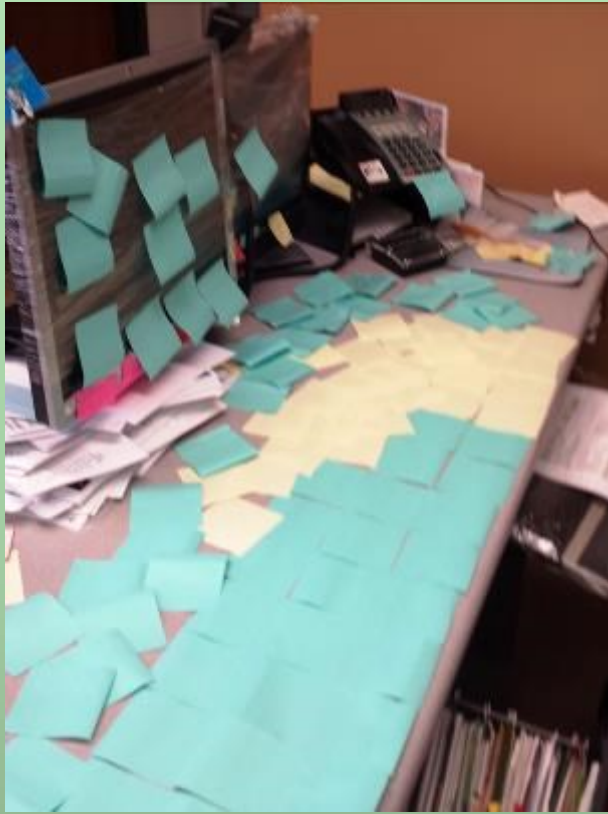

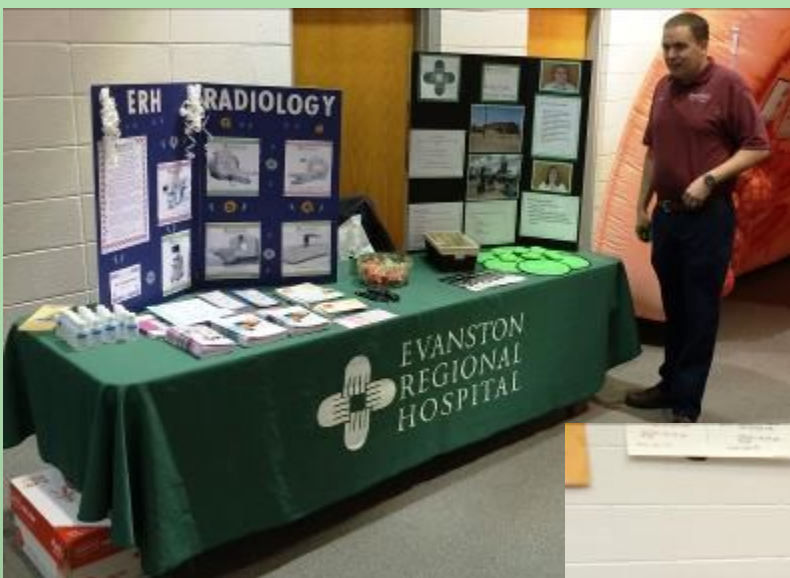

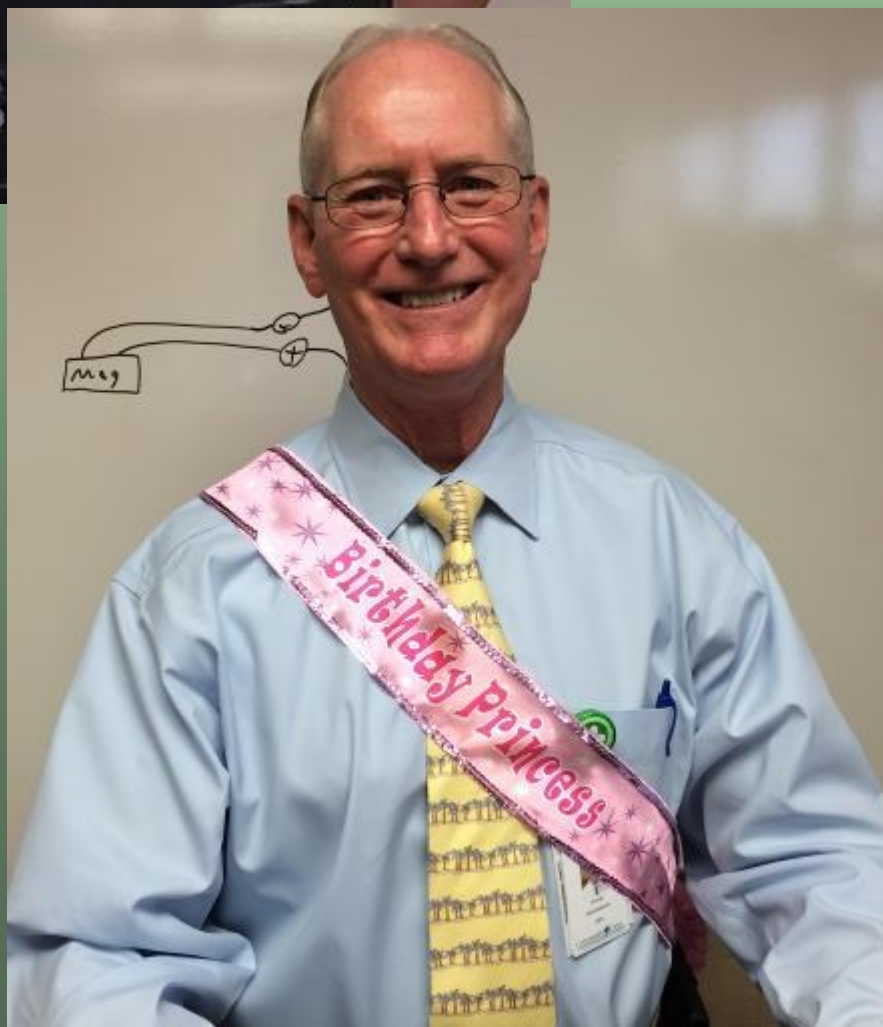
